Dear Sharon Dordon,

I conducted a special investigation because the child care licensing bureau received a complaint against your facility that related to licensing rules or law. The allegations were related to the following:

Rule/Law Number	Rule Description
R 400.1926(1)	In carrying-out its duties under section 5m of the act, MCL 722.115m, to determine whether or not a service, facility, applicant, licensee, child care staff member, child care assistant, or member of the household is conducive to the welfare of preschool or school-age children, the department shall deem any of the following behaviors as not conducive to the welfare of children: possession or use of alcohol, tobacco products, marihuana and, except as provided in subrule (2) of this rule, any controlled substance in a child-use area, or on the premises of a child care home while children are in care.

The details of the allegations are in the attached report. To investigate the allegations:

- I interviewed: Licensee, adult household member and parents.
- I completed on-site inspections on the following dates: 4/24/2024 and 5/14/2024

As a result of this investigation, I found the following violation(s):

ALLEGATION: Adult Household Member 1 was arrested for an exclusionary offense on 4/21/2024. She is not conducive to the welfare of children.

INVESTIGATION: I received a telephone call from Sharon Dordon on 4/23/2024 informing me that Adult Household Member 1 (AHM1) was arrested on 4/21/2024. AHM1 is currently detained in the Allegan County Jail, however, will soon be transferred to the Ottawa County Jail. Sharon Dordon is not aware of the charges.

I received an email from the Department on 4/23/2024 that AHM1 has been charged with Felony Dangerous Drugs.

I made an unscheduled onsite inspection at Sharon Dordon's residence on 4/24/2025. AHM1 has been residing with her for approximately one year and is currently unemployed. According to Sharon Dordon, AHM1 was bonded out of jail by friends on 4/23/2024. AHM1 informed her that she was arrested for an outstanding child support warrant but Sharon Dordon has heard from other sources that drugs were involved. I informed Sharon Dordon that AHM1 is being charged with an exclusionary offense and that she is to not to be left alone with children in care pending the investigation. Sharon Dordon intends to allow AHM1 to reside in the child care home pending conviction but will follow any recommendations set forth by the Department.

I received a copy of the sanitized police report submitted by Deputy Kershaw of the Allegan County Sheriff's Department. AHM1 was stopped by Deputy Kershaw at approximately 11:54 PM on 4/20/2024 due to a broken tail light. She was the sole passenger of the vehicle. AHM1 was arrested due to a warrant. Deputy Kershaw searched a bag that he had observed AHM1 placing items into prior to the arrest. The bag contained methamphetamine, empty syringes, a loaded syringe, and a syringe wrapped in paper towel.

I spoke on the telephone with Sharon Dordon on 5/6/2024. AHM1 has an arraignment hearing scheduled for 5/9/2024.

I spoke on the telephone with Sharon Dordon on 5/13/2024. An appointment to interview AHM1 at the child care residence was scheduled for 5/14/2024.

I made an onsite inspection at Sharon Dordon's child care home on 5/14/2024. AHM1 informed me that she has not used methamphetamine since 2020 and denied ever bringing drugs into the child care home. AHM1 explained that the vehicle she was driving on 4/20/2024 was not hers, but the bag inside the vehicle belonged to her. She explained that the bag of methamphetamine belonged to her husband. AHM1 took it from him approximately one month ago out of spite and claimed to have forgotten it was there. When asked where she keeps her bag, AHM1 stated that it is always with her when she is not home or stored out of children's reach in her bedroom when she is home. It shall be noted that AHM1's bedroom is located on the lower level where the child care is in operation. AHM1 informed me that her bedroom door does not have a lock, however, children in care do not have access to her room. I inquired about the syringes that were found in the bag along with the methamphetamine. AHM1 claimed to have no knowledge of the syringes and concluded the interview because she was upset by the information I disclosed to her from the police report.

Prior to leaving I obtained copies of the child information records and asked Sharon Dordon to call me to discuss the interview with AHM1. Sharon Dordon stated that she would call me in the afternoon when the children are napping.

Sharon Dordon informed me during our phone conversation on 5/14/2024 that AHM1 fears needles and she does not believe syringes belonged to AHM1. Sharon Dordon stated that children in care are not permitted in AHM1's bedroom. I suggested that the door is closed at all times and recommended that she put a lock on the bedroom door to ensure children's safety. AHM1 has secured a rental property and is expected to move within the next few weeks.

I texted Sharon Dordon on 5/28/2024 inquiring about a date for AHM1 to move out of the child care residence. I was told that AHM1 is "in the process" of moving and Sharon Dordon will provide an update when she knows more.

I spoke on the telephone with Child A's Mother and Child B's Mother on 5/30/2024 and Child C's Father on 5/31/2024. None of the parents expressed concern about the care and supervision provided at Sharon Dordon's child care home. The parents did not have knowledge of anyone caring for their children other than Sharon Dordon and did not have concerns regarding any of the household members.

I spoke on the telephone with Sharon Dordon on 6/3/2024. AHM1 has been staying at her rental since 5/30/2024, but has not moved all of her belongings out of the child care

home yet. I informed Sharon Dordon that I have found AHM1 not conducive to the welfare of the children and that this will prevent her from moving back into the home.

RULE/STATUTORY VIOLATIONS:

APPLICABLE RULES

ANALYSIS:	Adult Household Member 1 is not conducive to the welfare of children. She has been charged with an exclusionary crime. Law enforcement found methamphetamine, a bag of syringes and a loaded syringe in her bag. AHM1 informed me that the bag was stored in her bedroom located in the child care home for approximately one month.
CONCLUSION:	Violation Established
