Approved child use space: The kitchen, dining area and living room located on the main level and the lower level excluding the furnace room are approved for child care use.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): The main level of the home has three remote exits. The lower level has sliding glass doors and a staircase that leads directly to the main level of the home.

The family has a dog, cat, chickens and fish.

There is a drainage ditch located in the backyard. The ditch accumulates very little water unless it rains. The outdoor play structure used by children in care is located in the front of the home. Direct supervision is required at all times children are outside.
- Fireplace or wood burning stove? No Yes If yes, describe.
There is a pellet stove located on the lower level.
- Fireplace/wood burner in use during child care hours? No Yes If yes, describe barriers to protect children from burns.
The pellet stove has been inspected and has a permanent barrier to shield children from potential burns.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1932 Home maintenance and safety.

(2) All dangerous and hazardous materials or items must be stored securely and out of the reach of children.

Miracle Gro fertilizer was found in an unlocked kitchen cabinet and was within children's reach.

R 400.1944 Smoke detectors; fire extinguishers.

(3) A home shall have at least 1 functioning multipurpose fire extinguisher, with a rating of 2A-10BC or larger, properly mounted not higher than 5 feet from the floor to the top of the fire extinguisher, on each floor level approved for child use.

The fire extinguisher with a rating of 2A-10BC was not mounted on the main level of the home.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 07/07/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend that your child care license is renewed.
