## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records.

Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children’s records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:	
<b>R 400.1907</b>	<b>Child's records.</b>
	<p>(1) Prior to a child's initial attendance, a licensee shall obtain the following documents:</p> <p>(b) A child in care statement or receipt using a form provided by the department and signed by the parent certifying all of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Receipt of a written disciplinary policy.</li> <li>(ii) Condition of the child's health.</li> <li>(iii) Acknowledgement that the parent has been offered either a copy of the licensing rules for a child care home or has been given the website for an electronic copy of these rules.</li> <li>(iv) Agreement as to who will provide food for the child.</li> <li>(v) Acknowledgement that firearms are on the premises, if applicable.</li> <li>(vi) If the child care home was built prior to 1978, then the licensee shall inform the parents of each child in care and all personnel of the potential presence of lead-based paint or lead dust hazards, unless the licensee maintains documentation from a lead testing professional that the home is lead safe.</li> </ul>
Child in care statements including all required information are not on file for enrolled children in care.	
<b>R 400.1931</b>	<b>Food preparation and service.</b>
	(8) Bottles used for feeding must be labeled with the child's first and last name and date, refrigerated, and served only to the child on the label.

Bottles not being labeled and dated (if storing in fridge.)	
<b>R 400.1945</b>	<b>Emergency; plan; drill.</b>
	(4) Fire drills must be practiced while children are in care at least once quarterly, and a written record that includes the date and time it takes to evacuate must be maintained.
No fire drills have been completed. Fire drills must be completed every 3 months.	
<b>R 400.1952</b>	<b>Child transportation; parent permission; child information card; required when off-premises.</b>
	(2) At the time of initial enrollment, a licensee shall obtain written permission from a child's parent for the child to go on field trips that do not involve a vehicle including, but not limited to, walking to a park or in the neighborhood.
The licensee does not have written permission for field trips not involving a vehicle (walks in the neighborhood/park.)	

**Technical Assistance**

R 400.1905(9)  
Health and Safety Refresher 2022 is due by October 2022.

R 400.1918(8)  
Written permission needed annually for topical medications such as, sunscreen, diaper cream, bug spray, and antiseptic cream.

R 400.1931(4)  
Food (baby food) brought to child care by parents should be labeled with child's name.

**IV. RECOMMENDATION**

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend issuance of a regular license to the child care.
