## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS


This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records.

Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, there were five children present with Ms. Bennett-May. She was compliant with ratio requirements. While onsite, I observed lunch, nap, outdoor play, and free play. There was a sufficient amount of developmentally age-appropriate toys and equipment accessible to the children in the home. Ms. Bennett-May has made a great deal of progress restructuring her home to allow the children better accessible to equipment. Her paperwork was organized, and it was apparent that she had been diligently working on maintaining compliance with licensing rules. I observed her being nurturing to the children by holding them and engaging with them during free play. During lunch, she asked children food related questions making it an educational part of the children's day. The outdoor play area is located in the front yard. It is entirely fenced in, and it features a toddler climber/slide and various other outdoor play equipment.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
