II. Purpose of Addendum

On 04/19/2022, Ms. Carter requested the addition of the gray guest bedroom adjacent from the child use bathroom.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the license were modified on 04/27/2022, 06/11/2021, 06/03/2020, 05/08/2020, and 03/17/2017.

The facility is a one-story home with a basement located in rural Cheboygan.

Rooms and levels approved for child care use: The approved child care space in the basement includes: the playroom. The approved child use space on the main floor includes: the living room, entrance/laundry room, kitchen, dining room, two guest bedrooms and bathroom.

Areas not approved: The two storage rooms and wood stove room located in the basement are neither used nor approved for child care. The master bedroom and the master bathroom on the main floor are neither used nor approved for child care. The two detached garages on the property are neither used nor approved for child care.

Ages of children served: Ms. Carter accepts children ages birth to 12 years.

Equipment: There is a sufficient supply of developmentally appropriate equipment for the requested capacity of six children.

Proposed days and hours of operation: This facility operates Monday through Thursday 7:30am- 5:30pm.

Previous or concurrent licenses, including children's foster care: Ms. Carter has not been previously licensed for child care. Ms. Carter is not currently licensed for foster care.

Outdoor play area description: The outdoor play area is located in the fully fenced back yard.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement):


On the main level, the front door in the living room provides safe egress into the front yard, the side entrance exits into the yard adjacent to the unattached garage, and there is a sliding glass door in the living room which exits into the back yard. In the

basement, the stairway leads to the front door on the main level which exits into the front yard and there is a window exit located in the storage room. The window exit in the basement was approved under previous rules, so it is an acceptable second exit in the basement as long as this space is not modified.

There are no water hazards on the property. There are two small dogs and one cat in the home. Ms. Carter stated that all the animals have supervised contact with the children in care. There is a fireplace in the living room. Ms. Carter stated that the fireplace is not used during child care hours. There is a wood stove in the basement that is used to heat the home. There is a child proof handle on the door where the wood stove is located in the basement. There is also a hook and eye latch on the door that is too high to be accessible to children.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the addition of the gray bedroom (adjacent from the child use bathroom).
