III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff,

and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, there were four children present with Ms. Lyons. Ms. Lyons was found to be in compliance with ratio at the time of the inspection. I was able to observe singing, counting, dancing and the children playing musical instruments. Ms. Lyons read the children a Halloween book. I observed Ms. Lyons being nurturing toward the children. Ms. Lyons offers a variety of developmentally appropriate toys and equipment in the child care room to promote early learning and gross motor development.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

Technical assistance was provided on the following:

- I advised of the updated child in care statements and the option of not using a licensing notebook
- R 400.1945(2)(i)- A plan for how children with chronic medical conditions will be accommodated in all types of emergencies.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend renewal of the child care license.
