Dear Ms. Blaskowski:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 08/03/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

During the inspection, I reviewed sleep equipment, childcare records, MiRegistry trainings, childcare staff member interactions with children, tornado/fire drills, criminal background paperwork, diapering/toileting, and programming. There were four children present with Ms. Blaskowski. I observed Ms. Blaskowski being attentive to the childcare children. I witnessed Ms. Blaskowski holding, hugging, and nurturing the children throughout the inspection. She was observed verbally encouraging the children, carrying the children, and appropriately redirecting the children. I found Ms. Blaskowski in compliance with capacity and ratio rules. I observed children engaged in watching an appropriate television program. Ms. Blaskowski has a sufficient amount of developmentally appropriate equipment in the childcare home. Ms. Blaskowski utilizes story time, letter recognition, basic communication, music and dance to promote language development with the children. To promote early mathematics, the children have access to puzzles, hopscotch, counting beads on strings as well as counting during play mealtime. To promote early science, the children dig for bugs outside, play with animals and did a cocoon into butterfly activity. The children can access swings, a slide, a climber and various outdoor toys to promote physical development.

There were no rule violations.

- I provided guidance on crisis management plans.


