Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records.

Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, I observed children engaged in free play. The child care home is well maintained and clean. New outdoor equipment has been added and outdoor play is a frequent activity.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
