III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

When I arrived Ms. McCall was providing care to six unrelated children. Children were engaged in matching the amount of dots to numbers. She has developmentally appropriate equipment accessible for the children to use. The equipment is organized and inviting. Ms. McCall uses appropriate communication skills with children and provides an environment and programming conducive to learning.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1944 Smoke detectors; fire extinguishers.

(1) Operable smoke detectors approved by a nationally recognized testing laboratory must be installed and maintained on each floor of the home, including the basement, and in all sleeping areas and bedrooms used by children in care.

Ms. McCall did not ensure she had an operable smoke detector upstairs. The batteries were removed from the smoke detector making it inoperable.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-7).
