As a result of the renewal inspection on 5/24/2022, I did not find any rule or law violations. You will receive your regular license in the mail.



Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There are two remote exits on the main level of the home, the front door and a sliding glass door that leads to the back yard. The staircase to the main level of the home and a window exit in the bedroom on the second level of the home will be used as exits. The basement exits include the staircase to the main level of the home and an egress window that leads to the driveway on the south side of the home.
