During the onsite inspection, I observed free-play. I observed Ms. LaFay on the floor with children, using positive communication and consistent interaction with the children. Ms. LaFay stated she incorporates learning into play and when the children are old enough for preschool curriculum, she uses My Father's World.

During the Interim inspection, licensing consultant Wendy McBride found 1 violations. The violations are listed and explained below. An acceptable written corrective action plan was received on 3/21/2024.
