Approved child use space: On the main level, the entrance way, the living room, the play room, the kitchen, the dining room, and the bathroom.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): On the main level, the front entrance provides direct egress to the outside adjacent to the driveway. In the living room on the main level, there is a sliding glass door which provides safe passage to a balcony. The staircase on the upper level exits to the main level. In the basement, there is a door which exits directly outside underneath the balcony. The staircase from the basement leads to the main level.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, there were six children with Ms. Tarvainen. She was compliant with ratio and group size requirements. While onsite, I observed infant feeding, lunch time, and free play. Ms. Tarvainen's original license was issued in December 2021, but she did not start taking children until April 2022. I observed Ms. Tarvainen engage in tummy time with one of the infants. I witnessed her positively redirect behavior with children to enforce safety in the home. She was found to be nurturing toward all of the children. Ms. Tarvainen has an adequate amount of developmentally age-appropriate toys and equipment in the home. The outdoor play area is located in the back yard. It features a sandbox, several toddler slides, a balance beam, and various outdoor play equipment for the children.


The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

Technical Assistance and Consultation were provided on the following:

- I provided guidance on the outdoor play area. Ms. Tarvainen understands that the fire pit and the garage doors must not be accessible to children during outdoor play.
- We discussed ensuring that parents receive a copy of the child in care statement forms.
- **Licensing Summary Sheet-Technical Assistance:** Ms. Tarvainen will use a licensing summary sheet to identify reports in her licensing notebook.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license.
