Dear Ms. Hall:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 09/06/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

The violations that were found are:

**R 400.1905                      Training.**

(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:

(c) Prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment.

At the time of the inspection, child care staff member Stephanie Bowerman had not completed this course through the Health and Safety Course 2 of the MiRegistry.org website. Ms. Hall stated that Ms. Bowerman will take the course as soon as possible.

**R 400.1905**

**Training.**

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(c) Prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions.

(e) Precautions in transporting children.

(f) Building and physical premises safety.

(g) All hazards emergency preparedness and response planning.

At the time of the inspection, Ms. Bowerman had not completed these courses through the required Health and Safety Course 2 of the MiRegistry.org website. Ms. Hall stated that Ms. Bowerman will take the course as soon as possible. On September 08, 2022, I emailed the information to Ms. Hall.

**R 400.1905**

**Training**

(9) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 months of the notice.

At the time of the inspection, Ms. Bowerman had not completed the required Health and Safety Refresher Course for 2021 on the www.MiRegistry.org website. Ms. Hall stated that Ms. Bowerman will take the course as soon as possible. On September 08, 2022, I emailed the private link to Ms. Hall.

**R 400.1932**

**Home maintenance and safety.**

(2) All dangerous and hazardous materials or items must be stored securely and out of the reach of children.

At the time of the inspection, I observed cleaning supplies in the living room (near the diaper station) within reach of the child care children, who were present. Ms. Hall stated that she had just used them and meant to put them away. We discussed storing them on the mantle or a higher location.

**Electrical service; maintenance.**

(2) All electrical outlets, including outlets on multiple outlet devices, accessible to children must have safety covers or be tamper resistant outlets.

Due to the violations identified in the report, **a written corrective action plan** is required. The corrective action plan is due 15 days from the date of this letter and must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.

- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

A follow-up inspection may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be made in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

During the inspection, I provided Ms. Hall, technical assistance and consultation on the following rules:

- The children's forms (I mailed new ones so the most current ones are being used)
- Maintaining the background check website with all current staffing.
- Posting the latest Recall List. I emailed/and mailed her the latest version for July 2022.

Your facility was found to be in compliance with the requirements of Act No. 116 of the Public Acts of 1973, as amended and the applicable Administrative Rules.

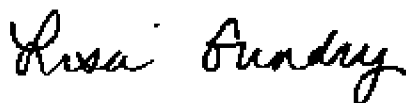
