Dear Ms. McDonald:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 09/22/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.1905 Training

(9) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 months of the notice.

Ms. McDonald did not complete the required Health and Safety refresher training for 2021. She stated that she was unaware that she missed this training. She agreed to complete the training within 2 weeks of me sending her the private link.

R 400.1934

Heating; ventilation; lighting; radon.

(4) A licensee shall test the child care home for the concentration of radon gas before the initial license is issued and every 4 years thereafter at the time of license renewal.

A radon test has not been completed since 2016. I provided Ms. McDonald with technical assistance on obtaining a test during the renewal inspection in 2021 but the test results were never completed. Ms. McDonald agreed to purchase a new test within two weeks and obtain the results this time (and send in to licensing).

Violations were identified at the time of the inspection. You have provided an acceptable written corrective action plan.

During the inspection, I provided Ms. Simpson, technical assistance and consultation on the following rules:

- The children’s forms (I mailed new ones so the most current ones are being used)
- Maintaining the background check website with all current staffing.
- Posting the latest Recall List. I emailed/and mailed her the latest version for July 2022.


Your facility was found to be in compliance with the requirements of Act No. 116 of the Public Acts of 1973, as amended and the applicable Administrative Rules.
