Findings of the Inspection

The renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center [administrative rules](#) and [statutes](#). Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the renewal inspection, licensing consultant Kelly Millar found 44 violations. The violations are listed and explained below. An acceptable written corrective action plan was received on 1/4/2024. A regular license will be issued.

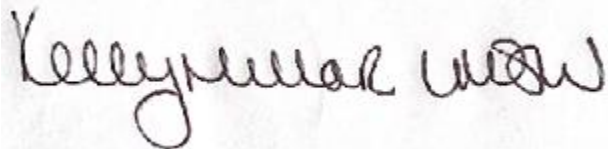

R 400.1915(5)	As required by section 15 of the children's product safety act, 2000 PA 219, MCL 722.1065, a licensee shall conspicuously post in the child care home an updated copy of the list of recalled or unsafe children's products that is provided by the department through its Michigan Child Care Matters (MCCM) online newsletter and available at the department's website www.michigan.gov/mccmatters .
R 400.1932(1)	The structure, premises, and furnishings of a child care home must be in good repair and maintained in a clean, safe, and comfortable condition.
R 400.1952(2)	At the time of initial enrollment, a licensee shall obtain written permission from a child's parent for the child to go on field trips that do not involve a vehicle including, but not limited to, walking to a park or in the neighborhood.
R 400.1913(3)(g)	Use time out for children under 3 years old.
