I observed a child watching TV and playing on his hand-held device. He appeared happy, caregiver appeared nurturing and kind.


During the Interim inspection, licensing consultant Kelly Millar found 0 violations.

R 400.1914(4)	<p>Television, video tapes, movies, electronic devices, and computers must be limited to not more than 2 hours per day and to programs designed for children's education, enjoyment, or both. Other activities must be available to children during television and movie viewing.</p> <p>Licensee will ensure media is limited to two hours a day or less.</p>
R 400.1903(1)(h)	<p>The report required in subdivision (g) of this subrule shall be made using the department's form named notification of Changes in Status – Family and Group Child Care Homes, which is labeled BCAL'(1)485."</p> <p>Licensee will ensure when the composition of her home changes she notifies the department.</p>
R 400.1916(4)	<p>All cribs, play yards, or porta-cribs must be equipped with a firm, tight-fitting mattress with a waterproof, washable covering, as recommended and approved by the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission.</p> <p>Licensee will ensure the pack-n- play mattress is a tight fitting with no gaps.</p>
