

Approved child use space: The dining room, kitchen, master bedroom, second bedroom on the south side, and living room on the main floor of the home are approved for child use. The basement, beginning at the bottom of the stairs out toward the south exit door is also approved for child use.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): The front door exits from the living room onto a small deck with steps leading to the front yard. The sliding door adjacent to the dining room exits onto a deck leading to the back yard. The third exit is a side door located in the mudroom off of the dining room that provides access into the garage with front and back doors leading to either side of the home. The basement exits include a large glass door leading out to ground level on the south side of the home, and the remotely located stairway leading to the main level.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection I observed indoor and outdoor play time, bodily care routines, and nap time. Ms. Klingelsmith provided direct and indirect supervision of children during play time activities. She spoke kindly to children and engaged in nurturing contact to support their social emotional needs.


The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

Technical Assistance was provided on the following:

- Outdoor play area safety: moving the tire climber or the edging/sand barrier to create a 6-foot fall zone.
- Ensuring the outdoor play area has adequate surfacing under climbing equipment.
- Listing cats in the pet section on all Child in Care Statements.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
