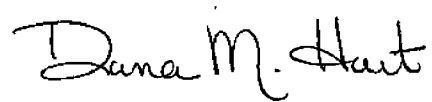

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

When I arrived on-site, Ms. Annette Pierce was present; along with one related child in attendance. The child was eating breakfast. Once they had finished eating, they played with the container of beans and noodles that Ms. Pierce had available for use. The child was observed using a variety of measuring items to scoop the beans and noodles into containers. Ms. Pierce was very attentive to the child's wants and needs and provided positive words of encouragement. Ms. Pierce does not provide care for infants; therefore, safe sleep rules were not observed or discussed at this time.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
