
R400.1941(2) Heat-producing equipment.	The following items were found within 4 ft. of the furnace and water heater: a plastic garbage bag with empty cans, a large blanket/fabric cover over the dog kennel and a dog bed.	Ms. Freeborn will take down the items and keep them down.	04/20/2022
R400.1944(3) Smoke detectors; fire extinguishers.	The fire extinguisher could not be located.	Ms. Freeborn will find and mount the fire extinguisher.	04/22/2022

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
