Approved child use space: The main floor and basement are approved for child use. On the main floor the kitchen, dining room, living room, two bedrooms and two bathrooms are approved child use space. In the basement the living room, bathroom and kitchen area are approved for child use.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): On the main floor there are three exits. The first is located on the south east side of the home and leads to the backyard/drive. The second is located on the west side of the home and leads to the large front yard. The third is located on the east side of the home and leads to the attached deck in the backyard. In the basement there are two exits. The first is the stairway exit that leads directly to the garage exit on the south east side of the home. The second is a door that is to grade in the walkout portion on the east side of the home and leads directly to the backyard.
