During the renewal inspection on 4/11/2023, I found *two* violations. The violations are listed below and explained in the attached report:

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 5/3/2023. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.

- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, a regular license will be issued. You will receive it in the mail.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and

training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1907 Child's records.

(1) Prior to a child's initial attendance, a licensee shall obtain the following documents:

(a) A completed child information card on a form provided by the department or a comparable substitute approved by the department.

Of the seven child information cards reviewed, five of them were missing some of the following information:

- Telephone number of child's physician (1)
- Place of father's employment (1)
- Telephone number of father's place of employment (4)
- Telephone number of mother's place of employment (1)

R 400.1932 Home maintenance and safety.

(3) All steps, stairs, porches, and elevated structures to which children in care have access must be protected to prevent falls, and must be free of ice and snow accumulation.

On the day of the inspection, the gate blocking the steps to the second level was not in place.

IV. RECOMMENDATION:

Renewal of this family child care home license is recommended upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan.
