Approved child use space: Ms. Pinckney lives in a two-story home with a basement. The main level and basement of the home are approved for child care. The living room, dining room, kitchen, and family room on the main level and the main room in the basement are approved for use. The bedroom upstairs on the west side is approved for use.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There is a front, side and rear door to the home on the main level of the home. In addition to the stairs leading to the main level of the home, there is a walk-out door leading to the back yard and a designated exit window with stairs leading to the window that can be used for emergency escape in the basement. In addition to the stairs leading to the main level of the home, there is an exit window in the bedroom on the west side upstairs.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the onsite inspection I observed hand washing and outside time. Interactions between Ms. Pinckney and the children were positive and developmentally appropriate. Ms. Pinckney uses Creative Curriculum with the children in care. There was an adequate amount of age-appropriate play and learning equipment.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

Technical assistance was given on crisis management plans, child in care statements, and recall list.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
