ALLEGATION: A child who appeared to be between 5 and 6 years old ran out of the front door of the home and was seen unattended on the side of the house for 15 minutes.

INVESTIGATION:

Licensee Tammy Bristol-Aldrich stated that the doors to her home are always locked during child care hours. She stated that the grandmother of two children in her care ages 2 years and 4 years drops the children off accompanied by Child A (female, age 7 years. Ms. Bristol-Aldrich stated that Child A could possibly look to be 5 or 6 years of age. Ms. Bristol-Aldrich stated that Child A may have been observed running outside when her siblings were dropped off. Ms. Bristol-Aldrich stated that even though this child has run out she has never been left outside unattended for 15 minutes. Child A's Grandmother always runs right out after her. Ms. Bristol-Aldrich stated that she has no idea what someone could be referring to and stated that children in her care are never left unattended inside or outside of the home. Ms. Bristol-Aldrich does not have any children enrolled in her care that are 5 or 6 years of age.



Child A's Grandmother stated that two of her grandchildren have been in Ms. Bristol-Aldrich's care for the last two years. Child A's Grandmother stated that Ms. Bristol-Aldrich is wonderful. Ms. Bristol-Aldrich is always outside with the children when they play either in the fenced backyard or on the front sidewalk riding scooters. Child A's Grandmother stated that she often drops in throughout the day to check on the children and when the children are in the house the door is always locked. Child A's Grandmother stated that Child A did run out of the house one time at drop off, but she followed right behind her.

RULE/STATUTORY VIOLATIONS:
