II. Purpose of Addendum

Modification request received from licensee Tara King. Ms. King would like to add the basement to her license as child use space.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have been modified on December 5, 2022.

Tara King resides in a ranch style home with a basement located in a subdivision of Meridian Township, Okemos, Michigan.

On the main level of the home the bedroom located in the southwest corner, the bedroom on the south side of the home, the living room, dining room, and kitchen are licensed for child care use. In the basement, the large playroom and kitchen are now licensed for child care use. The approved areas were measured and meet the qualifications of 35 square feet per child.

On the main level the master bedroom located in the northwest corner of the home is not licensed for child care use. In the basement, the unfinished section of the basement is not licensed for child care use. The basement will be used for tornado drill and in actual tornado emergencies.

Tara King will provide care for children birth to 17 years of age.

The approved rooms contained adequate, age-appropriate equipment and developmentally appropriate play and learning materials. All dangerous and hazardous items were securely stored to assure they were inaccessible to children.

Ms. King will provide year-round care Monday through Friday from 5:45 a.m. to 6:15 p.m.

Tara King has not been previously licensed as a child care provider or a foster care provider in the State of Michigan.

On the main level the exits include the front door located on the south side of the home which exits to grade, the sliding glass door which exits to the north side of the home also exiting to grade, and a door that exits to the garage and leads to a second door exiting the east side of the home. The basement has stairs which

lead to the main level of the home and now has an egress window in the playroom that meets the rules and can be used for an emergency escape.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the addition of the basement as approved child use space.
