Exiting information (including second floor and basement): On the main level, the exits include the front door on the east side of the home and a door on the north side of the home which exits to a breezeway which then exits to the back of the home on the east side, to the front of the home on the west side and has an exit to the garage on the north side which then leads out through the garage door. The basement of the home has stairs which lead to the main level of the home.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the onsite inspection I observed free choice and snack time. There was sufficient developmentally appropriate indoor and outdoor equipment.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1932

Home maintenance and safety.

(3) All steps, stairs, porches, and elevated structures to which children in care have access must be protected to prevent falls, and must be free of ice and snow accumulation.

There was no gate on the steps going upstairs so children had access to them.

Technical assistance was given on access to pet food, consent and disclosure statements, use of extension cords, and grill covers.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
