There was an open shed located near the outdoor play area that contained an axe and two bows; the fence separating the outdoor play area from the retention pond had a tube fence with wide openings between the slates, making the retention pond accessible. There was also warping found on the wooden planks on the deck of the home.	The licensee will add a barrier to the shed and tube gate to prevent access to the noted hazards. Licensee will also replace the rotten wood on the deck of the home.	12/30/2022

R 400.1945(1)(d) Emergency; plan; drill.	There was no water hazard emergency plan established. A water hazard emergency plan is required due to the proximity of the retention pond located near the outdoor play area.	The licensee will create a water hazard emergency plan.	12/30/2022
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It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
