R 400.1932(1) Home maintenance and safety.

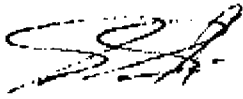

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records.

Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

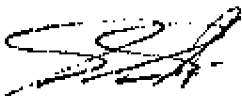
During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1918	Medication; administration; procedures.
	(2) Medication, prescription or nonprescription, must be given or applied only with prior written permission from a parent.
Two medication logs were not signed and dated by the parent authorizing the administration of medication.	
R 400.1932	Home maintenance and safety.
	(1) The structure, premises, and furnishings of a child care home must be in good repair and maintained in a clean, safe, and comfortable condition.
The banister/railing on the front porch of the home was beginning to warp.	
Mouse droppings were found in the bathroom drawer.	

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 09/01/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
