R 400.1932(4) Home maintenance and safety.



III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.


During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1920	Outdoor play area and equipment.
	(5) When swings, climbers, slides, and other similar play equipment with a designated play surface above 30 inches are used, they must: (c) Be placed at least 6 feet from the perimeter of other play structures or obstacles.
	The raised wooden perimeter of the outdoor play area is located beneath the slide. The slide protrudes beyond the border of the perimeter of the outdoor play area.
R 400.1932	Home maintenance and safety.
	(4) A handrail is required for 3 or more steps, or a total rise of 24 inches or more.
	The stairs from the back deck leading to the outdoor play area has more than 3 steps and a raise greater than 24 inches with no handrail attachment.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 09/21/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
