Ms. Ekins residence is a two store house with a Michigan style basement. The child care area is located on the main level and includes the entry way, living room, kitchen, and play room. The bathroom is located on the main level. The outdoor play area is fenced and is located at the side of the house.

The upper level and basement are not approved for child care. The basement may be used for emergency drills or an actual emergency.

There is adequate age appropriate play and learning equipment. Ms. Ekin provides the children with both structured and freedom of choice learning. I observed the children engaged in freedom of choice learning.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): The main level uses two remote doors for exits.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

I provided Ms. Ekins with a rule review regarding:

- Child information cards and assuring there are no blanks or "N/A."
- Infant safe sleep rule review.
- The 2021 Health and Safety Refresher course will be available soon.
- Emergency plans as outlined in rule R400.1945. The plans need to be detailed and specific to all emergencies listed in this rule.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
