R 400.1907(2)	Five out of seven child information cards and child in care statements have not been reviewed or updated annually.	The updated child information records will be completed by all parents.	10/7/2022
R 400.1910(2)	During my onsite inspection and in reviewing attendance records Ms. Bruce has been out of ratio by having 5 children under 30 months and 3 children under 18 months in care while being the only staff member.	One of the children will turn 30 months old in 4 months. Until that time she has been moved to part time and will be scheduled around the other daycare children. Both children that were not at the 18 month old age are both 18 months old now.	9/21/2022


R 400.1923(2)(a)	Diapers are being changed on the floor in the child use area. They should be changed in a space exclusively used for diapering.	Diaper changing has been moved from the playing area to the bathroom.	9/21/2022
R 400.1932(2)	Ms. Bruce had two melted wax air fresheners within reach of children posing a burn hazard.	The melting wax air fresheners are not being used during daycare hours.	9/21/2022

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
