There is a hot tub located on the back deck outside. There is a hard-top cover with a lock in place.

There is an above-ground pool. The side walls of the pool measure over 4 feet tall and are hard/solid material. The ladders for the pool are pulled up and locked to prevent access to the pool. There is also a fence around the top of the pool.

There is a fireplace in the living room but the gas is shut off to it, and it is not used by the family.

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes.
