Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.


When I arrived for the inspection Ms. Bedrick was in the kitchen with children in care. Children were sitting at a child-size table eating snack. Mr. Bedrick arrived home with their son. Ms. Bedrick has a sufficient amount of developmentally appropriate equipment for the children to choose from. She provides a warm and nurturing learning environment for the children in care.

Technical assistance was provided for the following: At the time of the inspection, Ms. Bedrick was waiting for Radon results. Ms. Bedrick will send a copy of the results to me via email or text message as soon as she receives the documentation.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
