1932(1) Home maintenance and safety	The home was not maintained in a clean and safe condition. It had too much clutter in a bedroom for napping. 1941(2) Heat-producing equipment	There was not a four feet clearance around the furnace/water heater. There were combustible items such as household supplies, plastic tubs, and food stacked next to and within the 4-foot perimeter of the furnace/water heater.	The provider will continue to work on the storage, furnace area, playroom, and nap room clutter during the first part of 2023 to make the areas more accessible and safer.	2/15/2023
1943(5) Exit requirements for each floor level used by children.	The exit from the basement playroom to the stairway to the main floor exit was partially obstructed by household supplies. The remotely located exit window in the basement storage room had a partially obstructed exit. The storage room was full from the floor to the ceiling with clutter from household items. There was a small path accessible to the exit window. In the event of an emergency, there would be too many items that could fall in the way of egress. The excessive clutter is also a potential fire hazard.	The provider will clear the exits.	12/22/2022
