Approved child use space: On the main level the living room, dining area, kitchen, and two bedrooms are approved. In the basement level the family room and two bedrooms are approved.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There are three remotely located exits on the main level of the home; the front door, a service door to the garage, and a glass slider door leading to a deck that overlooks the backyard of the home. In the basement there are two remotely located exits; a labeled window with steps in one bedroom and the steps to the main level of the home.

There are four dogs in the home; all pet supplies and equipment are kept inaccessible to children.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

I provided technical assistance and consultation on the following rules:

- R 400.1911(1) Care; supervision; children; ensuring language used around children is appropriate.
- R 400.1915(5) Indoor space; play equipment and materials; posting of the updated copy of the list of recalled or unsafe children's products that is provided by the department through its Michigan Child Care Matters (MCCM) online newsletter and available at the department's website.
- R 400.1936(5) Animals and pets; pet food, pet dishes, and pet toys must be inaccessible to children, which means locked up or up high out of reach.
- R 400.1943(3)(b) Exit requirements for each floor level used by children; ensuring the window used as an exit in the basement is labeled as an exit.
- R 400.1944(3) Smoke detectors; fire extinguishers; ensuring the fire extinguisher on the main level of the home is mounted as required.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
