Approved child use space: The living room, dining room, kitchen, and master bedroom on the main level.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): The front door and remotely located back door provide a direct, safe means of egress to the outside from the main level.

One dog resides in the child care home. Ms. Corson considers the dog to be safe around children.

There is a wood burning fireplace in the living room on the main level.

Ms. Corson stated that the fireplace is not used when children are in care.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

During the inspection, Ms. Corson engaged in positive interactions with the children during indoor play. The children played happily amongst themselves throughout the inspection. The child care home was well maintained and organized.

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1933 Water supply; sewage disposal; water temperature.

(4) Hot water temperature must not exceed 120 degrees Fahrenheit at water faucets accessible to children.

Ms. Corson did not ensure that the hot water temperature did not exceed 120 degrees at water faucets accessible to children. The hot water temperature measured 135.9 degrees at the water faucet in the child use bathroom, which can quickly scald a child.

I provided Ms. Corson with technical assistance for the following:

1932(2) Home maintenance and safety: all dangerous and hazardous materials or items must be stored securely and out of the reach of children. **Note**: all household items with packaging that indicates the product must be stored out of the reach of children, including, but not limited to, personal hygiene, cosmetics, and cleaning products, must be stored securely out of the reach of children.

1907(1)(a) Child information cards: unless otherwise indicated, all requested information must be provided. If the information is not known or does not apply, "unknown" or "none" is the required response. **Note**: a blank field, a line through a field or "N/A" are not acceptable responses.

1903(9) and (10) Licensee responsibilities: a licensee is responsible for providing identifying information to the department for adult household members who are associated with the license. The information must be provided to the department on the department's form named Child Care Licensing Information Request, which is labeled BCHS CC-001. **Note**: the form was sent to Ms. Corson on 12/09/2022 via email for adult household members Kalyssa Corson and Kayla Corson.

1945(1) Emergency Plans: review your emergency plans to ensure compliance with licensing requirements. **Note:** sample emergency plans were sent to Ms. Corson on 12/09/2022 via email.

1945(1) Emergency Plans: your written emergency plans must be posted in a conspicuous location within the child care home.

1913 Discipline policy: revise your discipline policy to include all prohibited methods of discipline. **Note:** a sample discipline policy was sent to Ms. Corson on 12/09/2022 via email.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-7).
