Findings of the Inspection

During the renewal inspection, licensing consultant Stacie Fifelski found 4 violations. The violations are listed and explained below. An acceptable written corrective action plan was received on 6/21/2024. A regular license will be issued.

Licensee had child locks installed on drawers containing dangerous/hazardous items (knives, scissors, cleaning products), but they were not functioning properly as I was able to open the drawers and cabinets without resistance.	Violation Established


		Child locks need to be utilized for all drawers and cabinets containing dangerous or hazardous items.	
R 400.1934(4)	Heating; ventilation; lighting; radon. A licensee shall test the child care home for the concentration of radon gas before the initial license is issued and every 4 years thereafter at the time of license renewal.	There was no radon test conducted within the last 4 years.	Violation Established
R 400.1941(2)	Heat-producing equipment. Combustible materials and equipment must not be stored within 4 feet of furnaces, other flame or heatproducing equipment, or fuel-fired water heaters.	There were several bags of water softener salt and plastic tubs stored within 4 feet of the furnace and water heater.	Violation Established
