Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During my on-site inspection the home was clean and organized. There was a variety of materials and equipment for the children to access. The home and child records were organized, complete, and made readily available. Ms. LaGrone has completed more than the required annual training hours.

I provided technical assistance and consultation on maintaining a fire and tornado drill log.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
