III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff,

and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During my on-site inspection children were waking up and having breakfast and then were engaged in free play. I observed breakfast being made and diapering. Ms. Gutierrez and child care staff member, Jesenia Amoros were interacting with children in a positive manner. The home was clean and organized. The home, child and staff paperwork were made readily available.

I provided technical assistance on hand washing requirements before serving children meals, staff attendance records, documentation of fire and tornado drills, and staff member document requirements. I have included copies of the Child Information Record (CCL-3731) and the Child in Care Statement/Receipt (CCL-3900) with this report.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1904a(2)(a) Child care staff member; employment requirements.

(2) Before caring for children at a child care home, an individual shall provide the licensee with all of the following:

(c) Proof of training in the prevention of infectious disease, including immunizations. Hours of training in the prevention of infectious disease from MiRegistry will be allowed to count for training hours to meet this requirement.

Child care staff member, Jesenia Amoros stated she is completing the required health and safety trainings on MiRegistry. Ms. Amoros stated she has not yet completed course 1 or 2 of the training. These courses include training on the prevention of infectious disease, including immunizations. Ms. Amoros was working on July 25, 2022, and has been working periodically prior to this date. She did not complete the training before caring for children.

R 400.1905(3)(c) Training.

(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:

(c) Prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment.

Child care staff member, Jesenia Amoros stated she is completing the required health and safety trainings on MiRegistry. Ms. Amoros stated she has not yet completed course 1 or 2 of the training. These courses include training on the prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment. Ms. Amoros was working on July 25, 2022, and has been working periodically prior to this date. She did not complete the training before caring for children.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 07/25/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
