

## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff,

and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During my on-site inspection I observed literacy activities, educational activities, and positive and nurturing interactions between the provider and child care children. Technical assistance and consultation was provided regarding the attendance.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**R 400.1935**

**Firearms.**

**(2) Ammunition must be stored in a separate locked location inaccessible to children during hours of operation or while children are in care at a child care home.**

During my on-site inspection, the ammunition was not locked in a separate location, it was stored with the firearm in a locked safe.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 09/13/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

#### **IV. RECOMMENDATION**

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care home.
