III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct

observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During my on-site inspection I observed children waking up from nap and given snack. The home had a variety of age-appropriate equipment for the children to access. Ms. James and her child care assistant were providing appropriate care and supervision. Both Ms. James and her assistant interacted with children in a positive and nurturing manner. They ensured that children washed their hands before eating snack. Home, staff, and child records were organized and complete.

I provided technical assistance on maintaining the Child Care Background Check system current.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
