III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records.

Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During my on-site inspection I observed lunch service, free play, and positive and nurturing interactions between the provider and child care children. Technical assistance and consultation was provided regarding moving a shelf in the nap room and TB documentation for one household member. It should be noted that the backyard is currently under construction from removing the above ground pool that was previously there. Ms. Ratering stated she is using the front yard for outdoor play until the backyard is cleaned up. She agrees to send photos of the back yard to licensing before using it again for child care children.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care facility.
