Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There are three remotely located exits on the main level of the home: the front door, a side door, and glass slider door leading to the back yard of the home. In the basement level of the home there are two remotely located exits: the stairs to the main level and a window with stairs leading up to it (grandfathered).

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations. A review of the program was not completed at this time, as there were no children present.

During my on-site inspection the home was clean and organized. The home and child records were organized and made readily available.

I provided technical assistance and consultation on the following rules:

- R 400.1905(6) Training; ensuring Ms. Barnes has verification of 10 hours of training per calendar year.
- R 400.1907(1 & 2) Child's records; ensuring child records are complete and updated annually.
- R 400.1934(4) Heating; ventilation; lighting; radon; Ms. Barnes will send verification of radon test and ensure it is completed every four years.
- R 400.1925(2)(e) Comprehensive background check; ensuring the child care background check (CCBC) system is updated.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1925(2)(a) Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting.

(2) An applicant or licensee shall do all of the following:

(a) Ensure that each individual who requires an eligibility determination pursuant to subrule (1) of this rule completes, signs, and submits all of the information required in subrule (5) of this rule, and in subrule (6) of this rule if applicable, on a form prescribed by the department. The forms are available on the department's website for the child care background check system, www.michigan.gov/ccbc. The form(s) must be signed and dated prior to the individual's appointment to be fingerprinted.

Ms. Barnes and AHM 1 did not complete the required Consent and Disclosure (BCHS-WBC-4001) forms prior to being fingerprinted. I provided a copy of the forms to Ms. Barnes.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 03/23/2023. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
