Findings of the Inspection

During the renewal inspection, licensing consultant Stacie Fifelski found 5 violations. The violations are listed and explained below. An acceptable written corrective action plan was received on 6/25/2024. A regular license will be issued.

R 400.1903(8)(b)	Conspicuously post on the premises a notice stating that smoking and vaping are prohibited on the premises during child care hours.
R 400.1915(5)	As required by section 15 of the children's product safety act, 2000 PA 219, MCL 722.1065, a licensee shall conspicuously post in the child care home an updated copy of the list of recalled or unsafe children's products that is provided by the department through its Michigan Child Care Matters (MCCM) online newsletter and available at the department's website www.michigan.gov/mccmmatters .
722.113g(1)	The operator of a child care center, group child care home, or family child care home shall maintain licensing records on its premises in the form of a licensing notebook. If internet access is available at the child care center, group child care home, or family child care home, access may be provided through the department's electronic database of licensing records for the entity.
