Dear Ms. Kalonji:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 08/10/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

During the inspection, Ms. Kalonji and child care staff member Deborah Mukendi engaged in positive interactions with the children during indoor play. The children happily played amongst themselves throughout the inspection. The child care home was well maintained, organized, and welcoming.

During the inspection, I provided Ms. Kalonji and Ms. Mukendi with technical assistance for the following:

1907(1)(a) Child information cards: unless otherwise indicated, all requested information must be provided. If the information is not known or does not apply, "unknown" or "none" is the required response. A blank field, a line through a field or "N/A" are not acceptable responses. **Note**: a sample color coded child information card was provided at the time of the inspection.

1907(1)(b) Child in care statements: a fully completed child in care statement must be obtained and kept on file prior to initial attendance. **Note**: a sample color coded child in care statement was provided at the time of the inspection.

MiRegistry Health and Safety Training: all child care staff members and child care assistants must complete Course 1 and Course 2 prior to caring for children.

1913 Discipline policy: all prohibited methods of discipline must be included in the discipline policy. **Note**: a sample discipline policy was emailed to Ms. Kalonji on 08/11/2022.

1944(3) Fire extinguishers: a home must have at least one functioning multipurpose fire extinguisher, with a rating of 2A-10BC or larger, properly mounted on each floor level approved for child use. **Note:** the fire extinguishers on the main level and the upper level are too small.

As a result of the inspection, I did not find any rule or law violations.


