III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

A. Description of Facility

Joshua and Chelsea Hall live in a two-story home located in Ada near the intersection of Honey Creek Ave SE and Pettis Ave SE.

Rooms and levels approved for child care use:

The basement of the home is approved for child care use. A bedroom and playroom area are approved for use by child care children. The playroom is a large open room that includes a kitchenette, play area, and sitting area.

Areas not approved:

The workout and storage rooms in the basement are not approved for child care use. The main and second floors are not approved for child care use. Child care children may enter the home from the main floor, but they will go directly downstairs.

Ages of children served:

Joshua and Chelsea Hall will care for children ages six months to three years old.

Equipment:

The home has a generous supply of developmentally appropriate equipment, toys, supplies and books.

Proposed days and hours of operation:

Child care will be provided from 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday.

Previous or concurrent licenses, including children's foster care:

The licensees have not been previously licensed for child care or foster care.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement):

There is a sliding door that opens to the backyard in the basement and a stairway leading to the main floor. There are three remotely located exits on the main floor. The second floor has a stairway leading to the main floor.

Outdoor play area description:

The side yard of the home has a play structure that is not currently approved for use by child care children as it is placed on grass with no cushioning material under it. The rest of the yard is approved for use.
