This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct



Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

Technical Assistance: Technical Assistance was provided to Lauren Kanyere regarding the landscape rocks she had installed to serve as stairs to her backyard. The stairs have no railing making them unsafe to use for child care children. Lauren Kanyere agreed not to use the stairs unless and until she installs a railing. Lauren Kanyere stated that she will use her front door only until she decides about the railing.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a original license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
