Approved child use space:

Ms. Stacey Wright resides in a one-story house with a basement located in a residential area of Adrian. The rooms on the lower level (basement) approved for childcare meet the 35 sq. ft. requirement for each child. The lower level consists of a large open play area that entails a kitchenette/dining area, living room, playroom, and a separate bedroom that is exclusively used for sleeping purposes only. The lower level will also be used for conducting tornado drills or during actual tornado emergencies.

During my onsite inspection on 6/22/23, I observed the children during small group and freedom of choice activities. All of the rooms were equipped with an adequate amount of age-appropriate play and learning equipment. Ms. Wright provides the children with various daily learning activities that include mane and number recognition, reading and writing activities, and arts and craft activities. Staff member interaction with the childcare children was positive and nurturing.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): The main level of the home has two remote door exits located in the front and rear of the home. The lower level (basement) of the home also utilizes two remote exits that include a stairway leading to the main level of the home and the other a remote egress window. The windows unobstructed opening meets the 5 sq. ft. requirement and is easily accessible, clearly identified, and can be readily opened by caregiving staff and children.

Approved variances -  No  Yes Description: Ms. Wright applied to have her capacity increased from 6 to 7 children. In addition, a varaince was granted to licesning rule R400.1910(1) ratio of personnel to children. The ratio of personnel to children present in the home at any time will be 1 personnel to 7 children. For each member of the personnel, not more than 4 children under

the age of 30 months, with not more than 2 of the 4 children under the age of 18 months, still applies and is not impacted by this variance.

**III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS**

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.
