Approved child use space: The basement, the half bathroom, and dining room on the main level are approved for child care use.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): This is a two-story level home. The second level of the home is not approved for child care use. On the main level of the home, there are two exits: The front door and the back door located in the dining room that leads to the backyard. In the basement, there are two exits: The stairs leading to the main level and a sliding glass door located on the opposite side from the stairs. The sliding glass door leads outside to the side of the house.

Mrs. Anderson owns the property across the street from the child care home. There is a pond located on the property. There are trees on both properties that act as barriers.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1905 Training.

(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:

(a) Safe sleep practices to prevent sudden infant death syndrome.

Child care staff member (T.M.) did not complete the safe sleep training prior to caring for children.

T.M. was hired on April 1, 2022. She completed the safe sleep training on April 27, 2022.

R 400.1907 Child's records.

(1) Prior to a child's initial attendance, a licensee shall obtain the following documents:

(a) A completed child information card on a form provided by the department or a comparable substitute approved by the department.

During the inspection, I reviewed seven child information cards. One of the seven child information cards did not have a signature nor (M.R.) was it dated.

Six of the seven child information cards (A.S., M.S., M.R., C.G., K.R., and O.F.) were missing information such as allergies, special needs and special instructions.

Technical Assistance and Consultation were provided for the following:

- R 400.1902 (1)(d) *Applicant; licensee; requirements*. Have proof of certification in both of the following: (i) Infant, child, and adult cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). (ii) First Aid. Mrs. Anderson's CPR and First Aid expires in June 2022. Please make sure to complete Infant, child, and adult cardiopulmonary resuscitation.
- R 400.1931 (13) *Food preparation and service*. Children shall not have beverage or food containers when they are in bed or when they are walking around or playing. A beverage container is any container that holds liquid including, but not limited to, bottles, sippy cups, juice boxes, and glasses.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 05/13/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend the issuance of a regular license.
