There are two exits from the second level of the home; two remotely located stairways leading to the main level of the home. The first stairway leads to the living room on the main level of the home. The second stairway leads to the front door on the main level of the home.

Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the on-site inspection the programming I observed included rest time. I observed the caregiver's interactions with the children in care to be developmentally appropriate and responsive to their needs.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 7).
