## **IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions**

The terms of the license have been modified on February 23, 2022. During the renewal onsite inspection on November 16, 2021, Mrs. Ibrahim requested the consultant inspect the den on the main floor area to get approval to use this space when her enrollment is low. There were no visible hazards in the room at that time. Mrs. Ibrahim was advised to submit a modification request form and to send pictures when the room is set up with equipment once she is ready to begin using the space. Mrs. Ibrahim will continue to operate in the basement of the home and will use this space for napping, and as a secondary child use space when she is closer to her capacity of six children. The den on the main floor will be the new primary child use space for play, activities, and eating. The upper/second floor level is not approved for child use. The only approved space on the main floor is the den area and restroom.

Mrs. Ibrahim continues to operate Monday-Friday from 7am-5pm. Nighttime care beyond 11:00pm is not approved at this time. Mrs. Ibrahim is aware that care beyond 11pm will require beds and prior approval from the department.

There are no foster care licenses at this time. There are no pets in the home.

The indoor play equipment is developmentally appropriate. The sleeping equipment consists of nap mats. Mrs. Ibrahim is aware that portable play yards must meet the current CPSC standards with manufacture dates after February 19, 2014. The outdoor play area is completely enclosed with a fence. There are no elevated or in-ground structures above 30 inches in height that would require ground surface cushioning materials.

The following areas are approved by the department:

- The main floor den (for child play and eating)
- The main floor (restroom)
- The basement (napping/ child play)

**V. Recommendation**

I recommend approval of the den area on the main floor as an additional child use area for play and eating. The main floor restroom is also approved for toileting and diapering children.
